Brief Description

This all-day event will provide updates on topics of interest to those involved in clinical research. We will start the day with a discussion of ethics topics, followed by updates relevant to the clinical research workforce. We will close our conference with a panel discussion with the speakers, joined by local HR representatives.

Objectives

Upon completion of this conference, participants should be able to:

1. Describe how to become an exceptional clinical research professional from a patient/healthcare perspective.
2. Identify research degree programs and strategies for career development in clinical research.
3. Summarize ethical considerations for clinical human subject research.
4. Communicate regarding the evolution of clinical research jobs and opportunities

Target Audience

This course is intended for clinical research professionals, including clinical research associates (CRAs), clinical research coordinators (CRCs), research nurses, principal investigators (PIs), clinical study managers, project managers and project directors, and clinical research administrators, working in academia or for pharmaceutical, biotech, or device firms, or for research sites or contract research organizations (CROs). Students and others interested in learning more about careers in clinical research are welcome.

To receive contact hours: Contact hours will be available for purchase for up to 14 days following the event. Purchase the contact hours, sign in at the registration desk, and attend the program.
